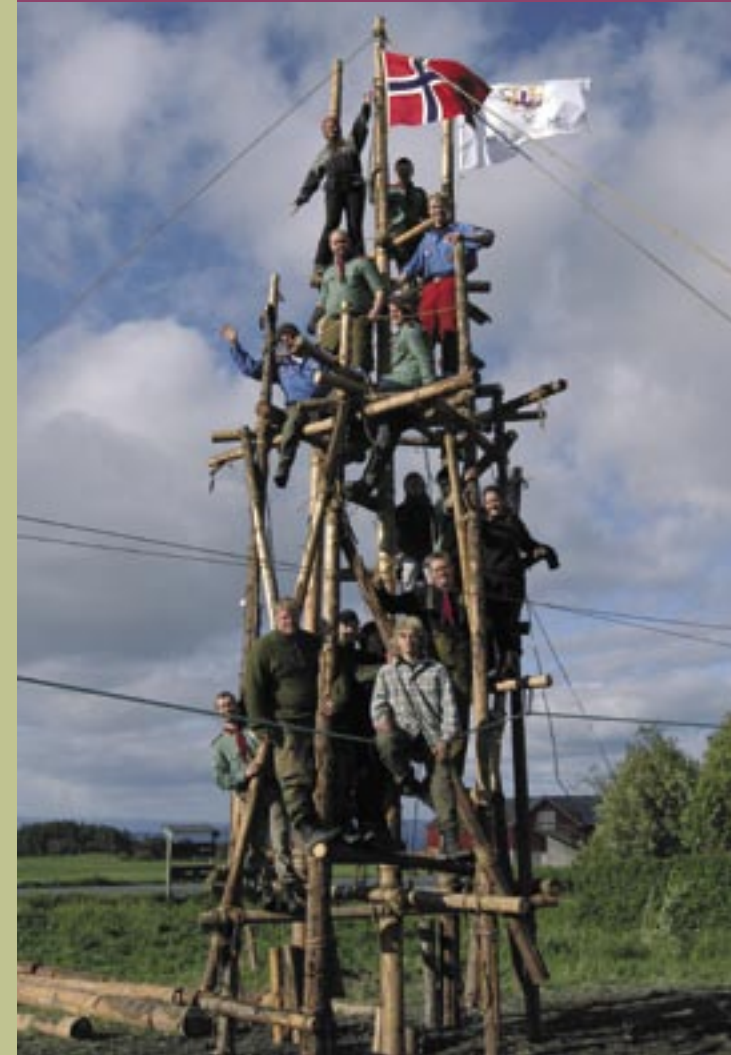

MOTTO

The motto for the jamboree is "Against the current". We all face currents we have to overcome - at school, at work or in life in general. You will get the opportunity to measure your strengths against the strong currents in the nearby river and also to overcome some other barriers by challenging yourself in different activities.

WHAT IS A RANGER/ROVER AND THE RR-JAMBOREE?

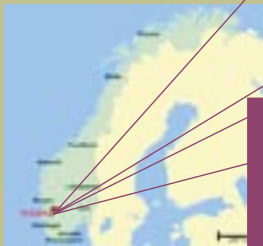
Ranger/Rover is the Norwegian name for Guides and Scouts over the age of 16. Sometimes the abbreviation "RR" is used. The RR-jamboree is a tradition in Norway and is arranged every other year when there are no other big jamborees. RR-jamboree is a jamboree organised by and for Rovers/Rangers and young Guide and Scout leaders.



WHO, WHERE AND WHEN



To participate in the SULDAL 2005 jamboree you should be a Guide or Scout born in or before 1988. The camp will be held in Eriksmoen, Suldal, in the south-western part of Norway. The camp starts on Monday 1st of August and finishes on Saturday 6th. We expect approximately 300-400 participants and hope that 10% of them will come from countries other than Norway.



PROGRAM

At Norwegian jamborees we sleep in tents, pioneer our own camp grounds and prepare our meals on an open fire. At a Ranger/Rover jamboree there are no small kids to look after, so you only have to look after yourself. We focus on the social aspect and offer a lot of activities that you can choose to go to... if you want.

ACTIVITIES

Some of the activities:

- exploring the mountains on foot
- rappelling down the tallest concrete dam in northern Europe (90 meters)
- extreme pioneering
- paddling the river by canoe
- competing in the RR competition



PRACTICAL INFORMATION

The participation fee is 160€ for registrations made before the 1st of March and 175€ for registrations after that date. This price includes meals and activities. Travel expenses are not included. The final date for registration is the 10th of May. You should bring your own tents and camping equipment, or contact us for alternative arrangements.
